- III.<u>Colossians 1:15-20</u> Jesus is God A. <u>Vs 15</u> – "Image/stamp/picture," "firstborn OVER all creation" = "begotten not made."
  - B. <u>Vs 16</u> "Created by him and for him."
  - C. <u>Vs 17</u> "In him all things hold together"
  - D. Vs 18 Body=Church. "Firstborn"
  - E. <u>Vs 19</u> "All fullness of God."
  - F. <u>Vs 20</u> "Reconciled"
- IV.<u>Colossians 2:9-23</u> Saved by grace through faith.
  - A.  $\underline{Vs 9-10}$  Just as Jesus has fullness
  - B.  $\underline{Vs \ 11-12}$  Circumcised = Baptism =
  - C. Vs 13-15 Christus Victor! "The Certificate of Debt"
    - 1. Proper 27, BCP 236: "O God, whose blessed Son came into the world that he might destroy the works of the devil and make us children of God and heirs of eternal life:"
    - 2. Prayer D, BCP 374: "To the poor he proclaimed the good news of salvation; to prisoners, freedom; to the sorrowful, joy. To fulfill your purpose he gave himself up to death; and, rising from the grave, destroyed death, and made the whole creation new."

- D. <u>Vs 16-23</u> Because it is finished, let's not argue
- V. Colossians 3:5 Pivotal "therefore"
  - A. Vs 12 "Clothe yourself" =

  - C. <u>Vs 14</u> Love!
  - D.  $\underline{Vs 15}$  Peace and gratitude go together.
  - E.  $\underline{Vs 16}$  Let word dwell in you richly.
  - F. <u>Vs 17</u> Do all in Name of Christ

- B.  $\underline{Vs \ 14}$  Redemption = forgiveness of sins
