## **REVELATION, Part 3: Heaven**

The New Testament \* Week 40 \* Opening & closing collect: Advent 1, BCP 211

- I. <u>Remember: Revelation of Jesus: past, present, and future.</u>
  - A. Past -- Satan and his demons thrown to earth <u>Revelation 12</u>
  - B. Present (AD 100) Letters to the 7 Churches -- Revelation 1-3
  - C. Future <u>Revelation 6-11, 13-21</u>. "Eschatology/Eschatological"
  - D. Eternity (Always "now") <u>Revelation 4-5, 22</u>
- II. The Resurrection of the Dead to Eternity ...
  - A. Old Testament: Fuzzy about life after death, with an emerging concept.
    - 1. Psalms and other places: *Sheol* = "death"
    - 2. Life after death/resurrection
      - a) <u>Psalm 16:8-11</u> (BCP) "Pleasures for evermore."
      - b) Job 19:25-27 "I know that my redeemer lives"
      - c) <u>Isaiah</u>
        - d) <u>57:1-2</u> -- Death offers "rest," not "the end"
        - e) <u>26:19</u> "But your dead will live"
      - f) <u>Daniel 12:1-3</u> -- Multitudes who sleep in the dust of the earth will awake: some to everlasting life, others to shame and everlasting contempt

Heaven and Hell were NOT a big deal in the Old Testament.

B. New Testament: God's people – and other religions – had ideas about it. Were all those "other" ideas mere mythology?

- 1. Jesus:
  - a) Several parables: "outer darkness, where there is weeping and gnashing of teeth."
  - b) <u>Matthew 25:31-46</u> Parable of sheep and goats.
- 2. Paul
  - a) <u>1 Thessalonians 4:13-18</u> (one of Paul's first letters)

"encourage one another with these words."

- b) <u>Romans 6:3-5</u> Baptism by immersion is a picture of dying, being buried, and rising again.
- c) <u>1 Corinthians 15:12-56</u>
  - (1) Jesus rose, so we will, too.
  - (2) New Body a "spiritual body" –
- 3. John: what we're reading today in <u>Revelation</u>

III. <u>Chapters 21</u> – Heaven is a wedding banquet that lasts FOREVER!!! A. <u>Vs 1- 4</u> --

This current heaven and earth "pass away." Burned up with fire, according to 2 Peter 3

- B. <u>Vs 5</u> --
- C. <u>Vs 6</u> -- Echoes <u>Revelation 20</u> and the white throne judgment.
- D. <u>Verse 7-14</u> -- *Close Encounters*
- E. <u>Vs 15-20</u> the city walls are 1,500 miles wide, long, and high!
- F. <u>Vs 21</u> -- "pearly gates" and streets of gold.
- G. <u>Vs 22-27</u> -- Gates never shut...

Hell is for people who want NOTHING from God. And God loves them enough to let them have nothing from him.

C.S. Lewis' *The Great Divorce*...

What else about heaven?

- IV. <u>Chapter 22</u>
  - A. <u>Verses 1-2</u> -- Heaven is a garden, with the River of Life
  - B. <u>Verses 3-9</u> We get to be with God, and without tears or pain.
  - C. <u>Verses 10-16</u> Outside are everyone who, by their life choices, demonstrate they don't want anything to do with God, his ways, or his people.
  - D. <u>Vs 17-21</u> We are ALL invited!
  - E. <u>Verses 18-19</u> -- Don't mess with the Bible! Don't Add to it or subtract from it.

**F.** <u>Verse 20</u> -- [Jesus] **says, "Yes, I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.** The Bible ends with a promise and a prayer:

G. <u>Verse 21</u> -- The grace of the Lord Jesus be with God's people. Amen.

The Bible begins and ends in a garden, and with grace, which is God's love.
