### **New HOPE for Our Community!**

The HOPE Center of Winter Garden opened last month in the building formerly occupied by the Edgewood Children's Ranch Thrift Store on Dillard Street, offering a plethora of services to benefit our community:

The Thrift Store continues Tuesdays through Saturday 9am-4pm, offering gently used clothing, furniture, toys, tools, kitchen ware, and media at great prices.

If you're cleaning out your garage or closets, please take your stuff there instead of to the landfill.

The Thrift Store produces revenue for the HOPE Center, but the main ministry of the place is to people in need. They offer these services:

- A food bank that teaches people how to budget their resources to get the most bang for their food buck.
- Job Placement with leads on temporary and permanent part-time and full-time positions, help developing resumes and interview skills, and free clothing to wear to interviews or for work.
- **†** The Opportunity Project opens doors for those with criminal records to find work and develop a track record of trust.
- Counseling Center: Whether someone needs only a friend with a listening ear or professional mental health therapy, the HOPE Center offers people ready to help, or, for those with deeper needs, referrals to professionals with more extensive credentials.
- Immigration Services to help newcomers navigate the confusing regulations about visas, work permits, drivers' licenses, and "green cards."
- Networking with other local social services agencies to meet the needs of anyone who visits.

Please visit the HOPE Center Tuesday through Saturday, 9am-4pm to shop at the store and ask for a tour of the facilities and services.

Our Outreach Team is giving \$8,000 to the HOPE Center this year to help them get off the ground.

And they are seeking volunteers to help in every aspect of the ministry, from sorting through donations for the thrift store to helping folks stretch their food dollars to listening to folks as they work through issues to coaching people in interview and job skills. IF you'd like to change the world with Jesus, the HOPE Center offers venues for doing that.



#### 2023 April Vestry Minutes Sunday \* June 18, 2023 \* 2pm

Present: Rector Tom Rutherford, Senior Warden Ron Lancioni, Junior Warden Mike King, Steve Borst, Beth Ann Carr, Anida Daniel, Mildred Dubic, Mary Kay Predmore, Joyce Taylor, and Apprentice Rector Andrew Lazo.

Absent (all for family commitments): Treasurer Bob Tate, Marci Babione, Sandy Sparks, Lionel Williams, and Sarah Wolfe.

**I. FORMATION**: Beth Ann Carr led Noonday Prayer. Based on 1 Peter 5:8-9a, Tom Rutherford talked about how the Devil prowls around like a roaring lion. As leaders, we are targets. He gave us an opportunity to share if any of us noticed an increase in difficulties in our life? We were encouraged to be aware, beware, be in prayer, and support each other.

#### II. INFORMATION:

- A. Vestry Ministry Team Reports: Outreach: Doreen Stachowski reports:
- 1. Bob and Patty Tate visited the Maxey Center Advisory Committee meeting. They are planning a Back to School activity and we are helping with 80 backpacks that include all of the supplies the children will need. Other churches are donating hygiene bags, food, decorations etc. This will help children age VPK to 12 grade.
- 2. Doreen and Anida Daniel visited the new Hope Center in Winter Garden. The Hope Center is in need of volunteers along with financial donations. The Hope Center will be here at the COTM on Sunday, June 25th at all of the services to share their ministry. We are also helping them with a financial donation.
- 3. We sent a donation to the Christian Service Center in June from our budget.

#### **B.** Staff Reports:

- 1. Children of the Messiah Preschool: The Financial Report was emailed separately.
- 2. Children's Minister Angela Lopez reports:
- a) I am hosting several cooking camps, and at least two art camps during the times traditional summer camps are closed.
- b) I finished my Diaconal Field Education with All Souls' Church and am looking forward to my ordination sometime soon.
- 3. **Messiah School for the Arts:** Co-Director Garine' Adams reports: Having not found someone to continue the School, we are closing our doors at the end of June, as Jeremy and I are moving to Virginia Theological Seminary for his studies toward ordination to the priesthood.
- 4. **Youth Minister** Garine' Adams reports: We went to high school worship arts camp at North Florida Christian Service Camp June 11-16. We're also joining the diocese youth again the last week of July for Soul in the City in Mount Dora for a week of service where our youth band will be leading worship for the week. - III. **DISCUSSION** about Security for our campus especially the Preschool: Vestry continued the discussion from last month. Nothing was decided.
- IV. **DECISIONS** (usually based on the Discussion last month):
- A. **HVAC Controls**: CES (Comprehensive Energy Services) gave us 2 quotes:
- 1. \$13,296 to upgrade and update the brains of the system and provide a new computer to run the software. This bid does NOT include checking the existing sensors throughout the system or replacing any that are defective. We'd have to deal with those one by one.
- 2. \$52,445 to:
- a) Upgrade and update the brains of the system and provide a new computer to run the software
- b) Provide and install new controllers for the air handlers
- c) Replace all the sensors and thermostats in all the ducts and throughout the system
- d) Replace the cabling necessary for all the parts to communicate with each other
- 3. Vestry decided to do the entire upgrade, but asked how much money we have on hand in the building fund. Fr. Tom will ask Bob Tate when he returns home and report the answer to the group, and then we'll decide for sure whether to do it.
- B. SIGNS: Beth Ann Carr presented information from two vendors on procuring new signs to direct newcomers and visitors around our campus. The decision was made to purchase the signs from FASTSIGNS at a cost of \$803.49.

#### V. MEETING MINUTES & FINANCIAL REPORT:

- A. Minutes from the last month's meeting: APPROVED.
- B. Financial Report from Treasurer Bob Tate: APPROVED.
- 1. **Operating Income** last month was LESS than expenses, INCREASING our year-to-date DEFICIT to \$48,117.64. PLEASE PRAY!
- 2. **Building Fund Income** was LESS than needed to pay the \$11,996.00 mortgage and other expenses, DECREASING our year-to-date SURPLUS to \$7,755.05.
- 3. **Designated Accounts:** A report with the amounts in each Designated Account was emailed separately.




