# Arch WHAT????

Our new Bishop, Justin Holcomb, has a keen eye for talent. For several years now, he's seen the selfless servanthood, pastoral people skills, extraordinary organizational ability, endless energy, effective leadership, and enthusiastic efforts of our own Office Minister and Deacon, Julie Altenbach as she's volunteered herself and our Messiah Team to help with Diocesan events.

So, naturally, when Archdeacon, (the Venerable) Kristi Alday retired, Justin called me to ask permission to invite Julie onto Diocesan Staff.

I want what's best for the Kingdom of God, so I gave him my blessing.

He issued a call to her, she discussed it with me, and she accepted it; and Julie is now The Venerable Julie Altenbach, Archdeacon for Formation and Deployment for our Diocese.

Okay! But what's an "Archdeacon?"

In our Diocese, the Archdeacon:

- 1. Oversees and administers the Institute for Christian Studies (ICS), the Diocesan school for preparing people for ordination as deacons, and that offers all kinds of classes for spiritual growth and personal enrichment.
- 2. Helps people who feel called to ordination as a deacon to work their way through the process of discernment: in their congregation with their rectors and vestries; and in the Diocese with the Commission on Ministry, Bishop, and Standing Committee.
- 3. Works with rectors, deacons, and the bishop to assign deacons to the congregation they can serve best.
- 4. Visits congregations when they get a new deacon to Celebrate their new Ministry together.
- 5. Pastors, mentors, and encourages the 80+ deacons of our diocese.
- 6. Referees between deacons and rectors when there is conflict or tension between them.
- 7. Conducts rehearsals for diocesan liturgies to ensure the REAL event goes smoothly.
- 8. And fills in any other way that's helpful.

As we've experienced in the Messiah family, Julie is uniquely qualified to do all of those! And her new ministry encompasses all of those, except #2 above, which is being handled by the Venerable John Motis, who is Archdeacon for Discernment.

Though I'm excited about Julie's new opportunity to change the world with Jesus, I know the question on most of our minds is, "What does that mean for the Messiah family? And, are we losing her?

No, we are NOT "losing" her.

She's going to work ½ time for the Diocese and ½ time for us.

Bishop Justin, Julie, and I are still working out the details, and October and November will be experimental months as we try different scenarios.

We know Bishop Justin wants her in the Diocesan office on Tuesdays and Thursday mornings for Diocesan activities, some Saturdays for ICS classes, and a very few Sundays for deacon events in local congregations. I want her in our office Wednesdays for Staff Meeting and Fridays for preparation for Sundays. And she's going to need a Day Off. Beyond that, we're still figuring it out. Please pray!

As far as Julie's ministry as a Deacon in our parish goes, that is completely separate from her job as Office Minister, so she intends on continuing serving with us as deacon on Sundays, with small groups during the week, and in pastoral care.

And for those of us interested in the financial details, Julie's transition will cost us half of her time in our office, but will also save us from paying half her compensation.

The Good News for the Diocese is: They're getting someone whom the Diocesan Staff already know, love, and respect from her several-year track record of effective servanthood and leadership.

The Good News for us is: Julie's raised up an excellent Team of 25+ Office Angels, who staff the office, answer the phone, greet visitors, print bulletins and this Messenger, decorate, set up for events, make phone calls for pastoral care and to recruit folks for funeral receptions and other events' so we'll be able to manage for October and November while we explore how this is going to work.

If we discover we need more help in the office, we'll work on finding someone for Julie to mentor into taking over some of her responsibilities.

In the meantime, please pray for Julie, for the Diocese, and for our parish family as we flesh out the details.

Please thank her for her dedicated servanthood in our parish family.

And please encourage her as she launches into this new adventure.

## September Vestry Minutes Sunday \* September 17, 2023 \* 2pm

Present: Rector Tom Rutherford, Senior Warden Ron Lancioni, Junior Warden Mike King, Marci Babione, Beth Ann Carr, Anida Daniel, Mildred Dubic, Mary Kay Predmore, Sandy Sparks, Joyce Taylor, and Sarah Wolfe; and Treasurer Bob Tate and Apprentice Rector Andrew Lazo.

Absent: Steve Borst (business trip), and Lionel Williams (with family)

I. <u>FORMATION</u>: Ron Lancioni led Noonday Prayer. Based on Philippians 4:19, Tom Rutherford invited us to talk about how to set our Budget for next year in order to change the world with Jesus: one child, one person, one family, one community at a time.

#### II. INFORMATION:

#### A. Vestry Ministry Team Reports:

- 1. Outreach: Patty Tate writes:
  - a) Bob and I attended the Maxey Center Advisory monthly meeting today as we always do.
  - b) It was the most well attended one we have been to so far. There were representatives from Christian Service Center, Shepherds Hope, Hope Center, West Orange Habitat for Humanity, Eight Waves Church, The Dream Center, Voteriders, and a few more. These people agree in the power of prayer and that God can change lives.
  - c) I met Justin from Hope Center, and he appreciates the Messiah volunteers that have already served there. They help folks get jobs, become US citizens, and learn to budget their money.
  - d) The woman from Voteriders helps people get IDs, drivers licenses, birth certificates, SS cards, etc.
  - e) Zandel Johnson is quite a good man who has a heart for people who need it. Bob and I love helping the Maxey Center and are proud of Church of the Messiah.
- 2. No others submitted

#### B. Staff Reports:

- 1. **Children of the Messiah Preschool:** The Financial Report was emailed separately. The surveillance cameras are installed and working. Director Barbara Ellerbe had major neurosurgery and is out recovering for up to 6 weeks. The Preschool teachers are covering well.
- 2. Office Minister Julie Altenbach reports:
  - a) Mary Kay Predmore and I prepared the Messiah's Way packets and catalogs. The Office Angels helped assemble them.
  - b) Mary Kay Predmore, Anida Daniel, and a handful of other volunteers handed out Messiah's Way packets to our long-time folks and made and explained the packets to our new family members for 3 Sundays. Any packets not picked up by September 11<sup>th</sup> were mailed to folks.
  - c) I enjoyed a week-long vacation with my family and appreciated the staff and Office Angels covering for me so I could go.
  - d) I continued to plan and prepare for the Ministry Celebration and Parish Picnic as well as Angela Lopez's ordination and Reception.
  - e) While on vacation, Bishop Justin Holcomb called me to be one of two archdeacons for our Diocese. With Father Tom's blessing, I accepted. Bishop Justin, Father Tom, and I are in process working out the details of what that means for me, the Diocese, and the Church of the Messiah as far as time, availability, and compensation.
  - f) Institute of Christian Studies (the diocesan deacon school) is moving to the Church of the Messiah. Father Tom, Bishop Justin, Facilities Minister Soner Alexandre, and I are negotiating the details and dates of the arrangement.

**3. Tech Minister** Vita Mazzaluna reports:

- a) I spent a few hours the week of Hurricane Idalia unplugging all the tech prior to the storm and then returning before business hours to check the status of the building and get everything ready for the work day. Thank you, Lord, for answered prayers to keep that storm from affecting us at COTM. (And continued prayers for those areas that did see ill effects.)
- b) Office Minister Julie Altenbach and I continue to support Katherine Reusch and Joyce Taylor in their volunteer efforts to make a photo directory a reality! There is photography before and during the Ministry Fair on Sept 17th and we are looking at one more weekend in October. After September 17th's shoot, the Office Angel team will help us identify those who may need social distanced sessions and/or who need to submit a photo for other reasons. The current goal is for the October sessions to be the last round so that the volunteer team can begin to finalize the directory.
- c) A parishioner covered the cost of a Samsung Galaxy A7 Lite tablet and case to use to control the sound systems from the audience during liturgies. I have been using a personally owned Galaxy Tab to run the sound and it has been excellent!
- d) Tech Intern Yolwenn Alexandre is doing amazing with learning how to proof-read the weekly slide decks! We are adjusting the scheduling so she is "first eyes" after Fr. Andrew completes them, so she can get more practice catching any errors. We continue to work as a team to hone the process in general, including bringing Music Minister Sergei Kossenko up-to-speed on how he can assist with proof-reading. We all also continue to be flexible as occasional errors slip by us all!
- e) Running the sound on Sundays at the 9:30am service is going well and I am definitely getting more comfortable. Long term I may still work to train volunteers for that role but I have also determined that applying that time to my weekly paid hours is helping me to manage my work hours and homeschooling hours work life balance and all that :) I will need to train someone so that it is covered in light of any absence so I will work on that with the Messiah's Way rotation.
- f) Overall, things are running quite well!
- (1) I will have to update the Sanctuary computer to Windows 11 at some point but prayers appreciated that it doesn't get forced before all our other Livestreaming software is fully ready for it!
- (2) The tech team continues to serve diligently, and we are only losing one volunteer that I am aware of due to a pending move. Prayers for the Lord to send the right person or two to help fill that gap through the Messiah's Way.
- 4. (Interim) Youth Minister Tom Rutherford is meeting with ACTIVATE on Sundays.
- C. Angela Lopez will be ordained a deacon here on Wednesday September 27 at 7pm. This will increase the retirement benefits we pay her to 18% of her compensation, starting October 1.
- **D. 2024 Budget Requests:** Please submit your 2024 requests to Treasurer Bob Tate at **Treasurer@ChurchOfTheMessiah.com** by Friday October 6, so he can give us a first crack at the numbers at our October Meeting October 15.
- III. <u>DISCUSSION:</u> Classroom Building Air Conditioner: The air handler, which was installed when we renovated that building in 1998, is on its last legs. Coolant technology has changed, so we can't replace only the air handler; we'd have to replace that and the outside units. R&R A/C, who takes care of all of our A/C, except the chiller for the Parish Hall patched it together as a temporary fix, and they are researching to tell us our options to replace the entire system. Those numbers will be reported as soon as they come in.

- IV. DECISIONS (usually based on the Discussion last month): HVAC Controls: In June we decided to spend \$52,445 to upgrade the entire control system, pending finding out the amounts in the Building Fund, and if there's plenty to do this capital improvement. Last month we decided to pay for it from \$26,598.81 in "Memorials" and from our Investment accounts.
  - A. Apple Air came to survey our needs and passed the job off to Automated Mechanical Services. AMS owner Steve Cardoza came out Friday September 15 to survey our needs. AMS handles HVAC hardware and software, maintenance and controls. Steve is compiling a proposal to do what we almost contracted with CES to do and will give a proposal to take over the maintenance agreement after our contract with CES expires next year.
  - B. AMS handles the HVAC for Wycliffe Bible Translators and CRU (formerly Campus Crusade for Christ), which both have massive facilities in Orlando. Our job is "small" for them, but Steve is a devoted Christian and specializes in serving Christian ministries. He also promises to respond within 2 hours if ever our system goes down.
  - C. Tom will report AMS's proposal when he gets it.

#### V. MEETING MINUTES & FINANCIAL REPORT:

- B. Financial Report from Treasurer Bob Tate: APPROVED
- 1. Operating Income last month was LESS than expenses, INCREASING our year-to date DEFICIT \$104,129.35. PLEASE PRAY.
- 2. Building Fund Income was LESS than we needed to pay the \$11,996.00 mortgage and other penses, turning our year-to-date SURPLUS to a DEFICIT of \$8,304.92. PLEASE PRAY!

The meeting closed in prayer and adjourned at 3:00 pm.

Hello Messiah Family,

We have been missing all of you. Things are great up here in Virginia. My classes have been intellectually stimulating and I've been getting to know my classmates better. I have been making time to bond with the other first year students and I'm enjoying learning more about them and the situations they've come from. There are twenty two first year students that represent dioceses from all over the country as well as international students. I was selected to serve as the class treasurer, though I haven't been given much information about what that title entails as of yet. The fellowship and sense of community here has proven to be a blessing as we've formed study groups to help with the deluge of readings (so far the average is about two hundred fifty pages a week) and the weekly Hebrew quizzes. 
