2024 January Vestry Minutes

Sunday * January 21, 2024 * 2 pm

Present: Rector Tom Rutherford, Senior Warden Ron Lancioni, Steve Borst, Beth Ann Carr, Mildred Dubic, Mary Kay Predmore, Sandy Sparks, Joyce Taylor, Lionel Williams, and Sarah Wolfe; and Treasurer Bob Tate and Apprentice Rector Andrew Lazo and vestry candidates Jean Pinder, Marie Tassy and Lamar Powers.

Absent: Junior Warden Mike King, Anida Daniel, and Marci Babione.

<u>I. FORMATION</u>: Steve Borst led Noonday Prayer. Based on Psalm 126:3-4, Tom Rutherford invited us to share how God has touched us through your time on Vestry. We each shared what we have learned through Vestry that has made us a better Christian, person, spouse, parent, employee, employer, businessperson, servant, or leader.

II. INFORMATION:

- A. Vestry Ministry Team Reports: None requested, since we just wrote Annual Reports.
- B. Office Minister transition: Wendy King hit the ground running on January 1!
- C. **Vestry Nominations for 2024:** Have been featured in the Sunday bulletins. We have 6 nominees for our 6 openings.
- D. **Annual Report and Meeting:** The Reports are published and available, and we're on track for the Meeting January 28 at 5:30pm in the Parish Hall. PLEASE ATTEND. If there are nominations from the floor for Vestry, the "retiring" Vestry members (Marci Babione, Steve Borst, Anida Daniel, Ron Lancioni, and Sarah Wolfe) will count votes.
- E. HVAC Controls: Automated Mechanical Systems has been busy upgrading our controls.
- F. **Maintenance Minister:** Tuesday/Thursday Maintenance Minister Matthew Barrett has agreed to cover us on the weekends until the Lord brings us our weekend person. Please pray for him/her to show up soon.

III. DECISION:

- A. Classroom Building Air Conditioner: Glen of R&R A/C kept researching our situation and the options and here's where we are:
 - 1. Installing two 5-ton single phase residential units and air handlers, would cost \$25,000 or more, depending upon how many other alterations they would have to do to fit the air handlers in, re-route ductwork, and wire the units and air handlers so they work in concert and not against each other.
 - 2. Installing one 10-ton commercial 3-phase unit and air handler would cost about \$42,000, take a week to install, and would require a larger concrete pad for the outside unit to sit on. This option is much simpler to install, operate, and maintain.
 - 3. Both options come with a 5-year warranty (It would be for 10 years, if this were not a commercial application).
 - 4. The vestry decided to go with the single 10-ton commercial 3-phase unit and air handler. Tom Rutherford will contact R&R to get it started.
- B. Vacant lots on Woodland Street: Stephan and Ariel Schmidt, who live in the yellow house next door to our lots, would like to buy our lots to preserve the neighborhood from development and build a small home for Ariel's parents. After a month of prayer and consideration, Vestry decided NOT to sell the property at this time.

IV. MEETING MINUTES & FINANCIAL REPORT:

- A. Minutes from last month's meeting: APPROVED.
- B. Financial Report from Treasurer Bob Tate: APPROVED.
 - 1. **Operating Income** last month was MORE than expenses, DECREASING our year-to-date DEFICIT to \$94,596.92.

- 2. **Building Fund Income** was LESS than needed to pay the \$11,996.00 mortgage and other expenses, INCREASING our year-to-date DEFICIT to \$13,373.23. PLEASE PRAY.
- 3. **Bob Tate** encouraged Vestry to be more proactive in prayer and work to increase our income this year. Beth Ann Carr suggested assembling a team to consider fund raising activities. She'll pitch this at the In-House Vestry Retreat Monday and Tuesday evenings, January 29 & 30 from 6:30-9pm.

Vestry closed with prayer and adjourned at 3:15 pm.





This month I read *Ordinary Grace* by William Kent Krueger, the book we're reading for the COTM Book Club. I think I would have liked it more if it hadn't been praised a bit too highly as "the best novel ever written." It was good, and certainly had extremely inspiring moments, but it was good, in my opinion, not extraordinary. It's narrated in autobiographical fashion by the oldest son of a



Confessions of a Quick Starter

For years, I have wanted to read the Bible cover to cover every year but every time I tried, my "quick start" tendencies would always kick in, and that would be the end of it.

Five years ago, a faithful church member (thank you, Stacey Beck) told me about Daily Audio Bible. It's a daily dose of the Bible which doesn't involve me trying to find my hard copy of the Bible, figure out what the appointed daily reading was from a list I couldn't locate, or any of my other excuses. Every morning, Daily Audio Bible provides that day's readings via a podcast on the internet or on the Daily Audio Bible app. You can choose the "cover to cover" format, the




chronological format or pick from one of several languages (including Spanish and French).

It took me a couple of weeks to remember to open the app and listen every morning, but I finally got the hang of it. (Hint: I set an alarm on my phone to remind me!) I listen to it in the car on my way to work and it has become a part of my morning that I look forward to and more importantly, I've been able to stick with it for 5 years!

If you have a new-ish phone, you can download the app and each day's readings are automatically pushed out for you. Or you can go to the website: dailyaudiobible.com and it's all free! You can't beat that!
