Chewing on Our Daily Bread

Questions for conversation with your family, small group, or a friend

1. Who in your life – outside of your immediate family – has loved you well? How did they show that love?
2. What is a habit, attitude, behavior, or set of choices in your life you've chosen to eradicate because of your relationship with Jesus? How did God help you do that?
3. Grace is "God's love for us AND our response to his love." What is a way you've felt God's love in your life recently, and how have you responded?
4. Ephesians 2:10 says "We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." What is a good work you're doing in your life right now? And how did God set you up to do it?
5. PRAY:
 - ✦ Thanking God for the people in your life who love you.
 - ✦ Thanking God for the grace he's shown you and the changes he's brought about in your life as a result.
 - ✦ For grace to continue doing what you described in #4.
 - ✦ For any needs in your group.
