We Prayed. God Provided!



As I've promised: I will NEVER ask you to GIVE more. I WILL ask you to PRAY more.

I've done that several times this year, as giving to the Operating Fund has been \$191,825.02 LESS than our expenses so far this year, as of October 31.

On top of our usual expenses, Junior Warden Lamar Powers (who oversees the condition of our buildings and grounds), has been urging the Vestry to invest in new roofs for our Parish Hall and Church, because those roofs are 18 and 20 years old.

With the deficit in giving this year, however, the Vestry has been reluctant to pull the \$120,000 out of our investments to pay for new roofs... especially since we've had several serious air conditioning repairs and replacements this year that have already cost us over \$100,000.

So, we, as a Vestry prayed for God to provide.

And I trust you in the Messiah family prayed the same.

We prayed, and God provided!

Here's how:

Hurricane Milton blew through, and we had 6 leaks in our various buildings, a couple of which were pretty significant.

We filed a claim with our insurance company. They sent out an inspector who found LOTS of damage. Since it came from a hurricane, the deductible is also a LOT. To make a long story short, after the deductible, they wrote a check for over \$80,000 for the damages. There is also \$20,000 in "depreciation," that they'll pay us, after we complete the repairs.

We also have a parishioner who runs a roofing business: Sunshine State Roofing of Florida.

He sent a crew out and repaired the worst leak – for free! He has offered to replace the two roofs for his cost of labor and materials... which come in a just under what our insurance will cover!

We can clean up the damage on the inside of our buildings ourselves, which will cost us mostly cleaning supplies and many hours of volunteer labor... but we have lots of folks who can make that happen.

The Bottom Line: We prayed, and God provided and is paying for new roofs for our Church and Parish Hall, which should take care of us for another 20 years or so.

Thank you for praying!

It works!

Because it works, please keep praying for the Lord to provide \$192,000 to break us even for the year.

And, if you need a roof or roof work, call Sunshine State Roofing of Florida in Groveland at 352-429-4531.

You won't get the same "discount" the parish family did. But you WILL get an honest roofer who does fine work, guarantees his work, and finishes it in a timely fashion.

Sunday * November 17, 2024 * 2pm

I. FORMATION: Mildred Dubic led Noonday Prayer. Based on *Building a Killer Team Without Killing Yourself or Your Team*, by Shawn Lovejoy, Chapter 13 (pp. 171-180), we discussed who inspires us and how to inspire our team.

II. INFORMATION:

A. Vestry Ministry Team Reports:

1. Junior Warden Lamar Powers reports:

- A. Wendy King provided plaques for the Memorial Garden, and they have been installed.
- B. The door to the ladies' room in the Youth Hall was kicked open. The lock must have jammed. Wayne Sparks repaired the door.
- C. Paul Buzzonetti replaced the light switch in the ladies' room in the Sacristy hallway.
- D. Other items will be addressed when funds are available.
- E. The church and parish hall roofs were damaged by the storms. Wendy King and Jane Cartelli filed an insurance claim. We received a \$80,318.84 check from the insurance company, and should collect more, when the repairs are done. Parishioner Larry Kulchar owns Sunshine Roofing, and has offered to do the job for his cost... which he anticipates will be less than the total insurance payment! He can get to it in the next few weeks. In the meantime, his guys repaired where the worst leak was from Hurricane Milton.

2. Outreach Team: Deacon Angela Lopez reports:

- a) Thanks to Patty Tate for leading the Thanksgiving Food Drive! We brought in all of the food requested and 20 gift cards! The Hope center will be able to bless many families with this!
- b) There is a parishioner sponsored Thanksgiving meal being offered to anyone who would like to come. PLEASE RSVP to me so I can keep her updated on the number attending as she is planning to do the majority of the cooking!
- c) Doreen Stachowski is taking the lead on the Edgewood Children's Ranch party. If you would like to join us the evening of December 7 to volunteer, please reach out to her or me, our information is in the directory and messenger. We will need help transporting gifts and food, serving the dinner, helping with crafts and games as well as voices for the Christmas Caroling! It is a beautiful opportunity to share the joy of Christmas and love for these kids living in difficult circumstances.

B. Staff Ministry Reports

1. Children's Minister Angela Lopez reports:

a) We finished the Mighty series and Spooky Stories from the Bible. The children enjoyed both. We are working through a series called Take Root. We will explore the following stories: David and Saul, Elijah and the widow, Daniel and the lions, and end with Ezekiel. In December we will have Rockin' Christmas as our theme.

- b) We will be making Christmas cards for residents at Health Central Park nursing home and having our Friends-Giving activity later this month.
- c) I have been slowly working in the children who have signed up to acolyte in 2025. They are doing a great job! I love seeing the concentration and reverence on their face, especially in those who are slightly older and can comprehend what they are helping with. We are still working on keeping them in the position they are scheduled for so that everyone gets a chance to serve in each position. I have started posting the schedule out on the name tag board again to remind them and whomever is serving as deacon where to put each server. I don't like dealing with sad kids and frustrated parents when it's not necessary.
- d) The SHINE kids along with ACTIVATE youth and some extra friends packed 14 operation Christmas Child boxes. They included a note to the child receiving the gift, and we are adding in the church address as Samaritan's Purse said some children will write letters back. This will be really cool for our kids. After stuffing the boxes, we prayed over them. I will deliver them to First Baptist Ocoee so they will be shipped with their boxes. They have a large production over there and have tracked their boxes for years. They first go to Atlanta and then most often to The Congo, so we are anticipating our boxes will be heading there. Of course, I will be updating the group on the tracking!
- e) I am working on the finishing touches of the Advent Adventure series that Vita and I are facilitating. Each Sunday in Advent we invite everyone to join us from 4:30-6pm for a themed activity, music and snacks. There is no cost, but we are asking for people to register so that we have enough supplies. Fr. Andrew, Fr. Tom, Archdeacon Julie, Vita, and myself will be leading different portions of the festivities. Simple supper on Dec 1 will coordinate with the activities.

2. Facilities Ministry enters a new season.

- a) Rather than paying a staff Facility Minister, the tasks of that ministry have been divided up among these folks:
 - 1. Office Minister Wendy King is supervising the cleaning service and Maintenance Minister Matthew Barrett, and she is ordering cleaning and paper supplies.
 - 2. Finance Minister Jane Cartelli has taken on the Facility Calendar, which means, if you want to reserve a space on campus for any event, please coordinate that with Jane. Her email address is: JaneCartelli@ChurchOfTheMessiah.com
 - 3. Volunteers Stephanie Abell, Beth Ann Carr, and Jane Cartelli are teaming to market our facility for rentals, meet with prospective renters, negotiate contracts, and supervise paid Event Ministers, who will be on campus before, during, and after rental events to open up, handle issues, supervise clean-up, and lock up.
- b) This reduces expenses, as neither Wendy nor Jane want to be paid for their extra duties, and Stephanie and Beth Ann are doing their bit as volunteers. We already pay Event Ministers to be on campus for events, so that is not an added expense.

3. Media Minister Vita Mazzaluna reports lots going on at Church of the Messiah!

- a) I've been working with Music Minister Ricky Jackson and on my own to figure out some things with the sound board and sound system to help our choir hear better and to support one of our rentals.
- b) I am continuing to adjust our Facilities Request Form and Advertising Request Forms to make them more efficiently communicate needs to the Facilities folks, Office Minister Wendy King, and myself. As with all technology related forms, they are a work in progress.

- c) Social Media Minister Yesika King continues to do excellent work for us on Facebook and Instagram. We had a Zoom planning meeting today 11/8 to get a handle on all the moving pieces for Advent and Christmas. Some fun social media things planned!
- d) I worked to clean up and prepare Chrome books and other donated or retired devices so that Deacon Angela can use them for her Safe Church training that will happen in February.
- e) Office Minister Wendy King and I decided that I will be creating bulletin insert fliers since I'm already creating the initial advertising slide and working with the material anyway. It's working great so far!
- f) I provided my Messiah's Way volunteer team with their Appreciation Gifts over the past several weeks:) I appreciate them SO much and am excited that most are returning for another year (Yay!! THANK YOU!!), and I picked up a new teen volunteer!
- g) Excited for ADVENTure with Deacon Angela and hope to see lots of you there! Don't forget to register for the kick off dinner on December 1st! https://COTM-ADVENTure.eventbrite.com
- **4. Music Ministry: Ricky Jackson** reports: The Worship Band is providing the music for Light Up Winter Garden on December 6 at 6 p.m. in front of City Hall, and for the Faith and Family Night for the Osceola Magic basketball team (the Orlando Magic developmental team in Kissimmee) on February 10, 2025 at the Silver Spurs Arena.

5. Office Minister Wendy King reports:

- a) We have a new recycle bin in the overflow parking lot by the Preschool! The old bin was an eye-sore, and one of the lids came off after the last storm. We had previously decided to have it removed since we no longer receive payment for the paper. I asked to have the bin removed, and the following day we had a visit from the company asking what they could do to keep providing us the service. After talking to Fr. Tom, we agreed that we would continue to recycle paper if they replaced the bin. We won't receive payment for recycling our paper, but we are continuing to do our part to help the environment. This bin is ONLY for paper. Feel free to bring your paper recycling from home. No Boxes, No Phonebooks, No Plastic.
- b) I prepared bulletins for funerals and helped with the reception for Betty Flood and Andre Estyle.
- c) Media Minister Vita Mazzaluna and I are praying fervently for a new Facility Minister. We are blessed to have a lively church, and we have had a handful of requests to rent our facility in the past few weeks. This recent activity has kept me busy communicating, meeting, and fitting these events into our church calendar. I'm grateful for the additional income these rentals will provide. Jane Cartelli has agreed to take over managing the church calendar. This transition will happen when she returns from vacation. I will be a back-up.
- d) Kevin Smith, our Insurance Adjuster, has been helpful through the insurance process and steps. Kevin referred us to two companies that could do the repairs of the roof and interior. I reached out to one who came and took photos and measurements of our roof. Parishioner Larry Kulchar, who owns Sunshine Roofing, has continued to be very helpful throughout this process too. Larry's team came out last week to patch an area in the roof that caused the leak in the Library. Larry met with Lamar Powers, Fr. Tom and me, to go over the Insurance Report and to explain what our options are for repairs. He shared that the insurance company has taken good care of us. Kevin cut us a check, and we should receive it this week. Woohoo!!

- e) Parishioner and plumber Daniel Puterbaugh did some projects around the church, including repairing the Preschool water fountain. Thank you, Daniel.
- f) Steve, from Automated Mechanical Services, the company that maintains our HVAC systems, completed the quarterly maintenance and changed out air filters.
- g) Sciens Building Solutions, who maintain our fire alarm system, came out because the alarm went off, because 2 backup batteries died and needed to be replaced. This was a new adventure for me. Now I know how to troubleshoot the alarms.

6. Preschool Director Barbara Ellerbe reports:

- a) The financial report was emailed separately.
- b) The classroom building will be tented for termites during Thanksgiving break.

7. Interim Youth Minister Tom Rutherford reports:

- a) ACTIVATE youth group will join in the ADVENT Family Adventure on the Sundays from December 1-22
- b) A new form of Youth Ministry begins in January. Details coming soon!
- **C. It's Vestry Nomination season:** Marci Babione, Don Greer, and Don Grimes have agreed to stand for election. We're trusting God to raise up at least one more.
- **II. DISCUSSION:** We discussed re-evaluating our current plan to pay an additional \$10,000 each month on the principal our mortgage. Bob Tate will get some information for our vestry meeting showing the current interest we are earning on our cash, brokerage account, and the total pay off on our current mortgage. So we can decide if we will continue to make the pre-payments on the mortgage.

IV. DECISIONS:

Diocesan Convention Delegates:

- A. Chris Brown, Sandy Sparks and Wendy King volunteered to be Lay Delegates.
- B. Tom Rutherford will recruit alternate Lay Delegates to fill the available spots.

V. MEETING MINUTES & FINANCIAL REPORT:

- A. Minutes from last month's meeting: APPROVED.
- **B. Financial Report from Treasurer Bob Tate**: APPROVED.
 - **1. Operating Income** last month was LESS than expenses, INCREASING our DEFICIT for the year to \$191,825.02. PLEASE KEEP PRAYING.
 - **2. Building Fund Income** was MORE than needed to pay the \$11,996.00 mortgage, other expenses, and the extra \$10,000 of month we're prepaying on the mortgage, INCREASING our SURPLUS for the year to \$4,588.62.
 - **3.** The remaining mortgage balance is \$513,152.40, and our Cash and Brokerage accounts total \$432,815.04.


Meeting closed with prayer and adjourned at 3:05 p.m.
